- During a typical graduation, you would be allowed to sit in the Honors Section and walk with a beautiful Gold Stole





How to Apply to be a General Member

- Visit our website https://eccags.wordpress.com/apply/ to download our application and submit your application to ags.cabinet.ecc@gmail.com
- Requirements:
 - 3.0 or greater GPA in a minimum of 12 units over the last two years in college (for continuing college students)
 - 3.5 or greater GPA for first-semester students (for students right out of highschool) <u>OR</u> life membership to California Scholarship Federation (located on diploma)
- Specifically for the Fall 2020 semester:
 - If you know have a GPA that is close to, but still does not meet our requirements, we are still encouraging you to apply, though acceptance is not guaranteed

Types of Membership and maintaining membership

2 main types of membership

• BLUE MEMBERS

- Our largest and most general type of membership
- Required to complete **6 points throughout the fall semester**
- AT LEAST 2 points for meeting attendance, 2 points for on campus events, and 2 points for community volunteer work
- \$20 initial, \$10 with Financial Aid

SILVER MEMBERS

- Designed for our members with OVER 16 units OR work 40 hours + a week
- Required to complete **3 points throughout the fall semester**
- AT LEAST 1 point for meeting attendance, 1 point for on campus events, and 1 point for community volunteer work
- \$40 initial, \$30 with Financial Aid

- <u>Dosomething.org</u> most "user friendly," low-commitment, fairly easy work
- <u>bemyeyes.com</u> -requires app download, work based off of demand, very easy work
- unv.org long term projects, best for college applications, difficult tasks
- https://www.chemoangels.com/angel-pre-app -- extremely heavy work, only suited for those with enough time to dedicate, must be 18+, long-term commitment, very good for college applications
- https://translatorswithoutborders.org/volunteer/ -- must be bilingual (duh!)
- https://www.cancer.org/involved/volunteer/online-and-social.html very easy work, must be social media literate, hard to accumulate multiple "hours"
- https://www.eac.gov/voters/become-poll-worker -- only if you feel most comfortable with going outside and talking to large groups of people

Community Service/Volunteer Opportunities pt 2

- https://www.pgdp.net/c/accounts/addproofer.php must have PROFICIENT reading/writing skills, proofreading works of literature
- https://careers.amnesty.org/vacancy/find/results/ similar to UNV, work is long-term based and opportunities may be hard to find, best for college applications
- https://www.redcross.org/volunteer/become-a-volunteer.html type of work varies widely, most offers are in-person, very easy to find hours
- https://www.zooniverse.org/get-involved assisting in professional research, very user friendly, easy to find a topic of interest for each user
- https://www.crisistextline.org/become-a-volunteer/ -- very emotionally heavy work, 30 hours of mandatory, unpaid training, work is primarily from 7pm-3am

- Given that the current restrictions have greatly impacted the number of volunteer opportunities available, if you find something that you think would work, just ask if you can use it for points!
