## Requirements for acceptance

- GPA Requirement:

  - For those with 12 units or more in college → 3.00 gpa

#### Types Of AGS Membership

#### **Blue Members**

- Most students
- Required to earn a total of 6 points
  - 2 points from meetings
  - 2 points of service
  - 2 points for campus events
- Dues: \$20, but with financial aid it is \$10

#### Silver Members

- Full-time job, 16 units or more
- Required to earn a total of 3 points
  - 1 points from meetings
  - 1 points of service
  - 1 points for campus events
- Dues: \$40, but with financial aid it is \$30
