

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS



- Most students
- Required to earn a total of 10 points
 - At least 3 points from meetings
 - At least 3 points of service
 - At least 3 points for campus events



- Full-time job (30+ Hours) and/or 16+ units
- Required to earn a total of 5 points
 - At least 1 point from meetings
 - At least 1 points of service
 - At least 1 point for campus events

***Remember to **record your points on the Service Point Sheet** (file is on the website) which will be submitted by the end of the semester

- → Meeting attendance will be taken by the board
- → Document your participation in other activities community service and campus events by taking photos or screenshots ***make sure to have your name or face in the photo/s for proof

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Go to our website.
 - <u>Alpha Gamma Sigma Alpha</u> <u>Phi Chapter</u>
- 2. Fill out the general membership application.
- 3. E-mail us a pdf file containing:(1) application, (2) transcript,and (3) essay.

- 4. Await confirmation e-mail that application was accepted!

REQUIREMENTS

- GPA Requirement:
 - For those with less than 12 units in college \rightarrow 3.50 gpa using high school transcript or proof of life membership in CSF
 - For those with 12 units or more in college \rightarrow 3.00 gpa or higher
- Dues:
 - 300-500 word essay instead of monetary dues
- APPLICATION DEADLINE !!!
 - OCTOBER 14TH, the Friday following our next meeting

Essay Topics (300-500 words)

- 1. "What does honor society mean to you?"
- 2. "Why did you pick your major?"
- 3. "Explain the transfer process"
- 4. "What does leadership mean to you?"
 - Or you can pick your own topic if it is related to academics, leadership, or service and must be approved by a cabinet member.

- <u>https://www.zooniverse.org/get-involved</u> → assisting in professional research, very user friendly to find a topic of interest for each user
- <u>https://www.crisistextline.org/become-a-volunteer/</u> → very emotionally heavy work, 30 hours of mandatory, unpaid training, work is primarily from 7pm-3am
