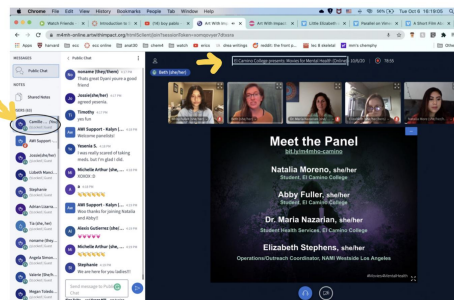

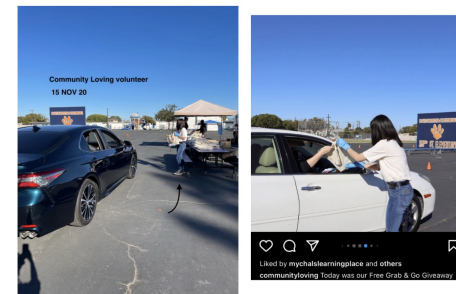
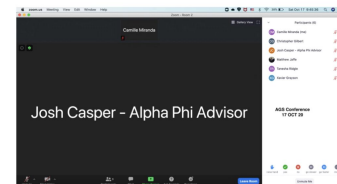
When this is over, may we never again like far grander
