04


During graduation, you would be allowed to sit in the Honors Section and walk with a beautiful Gold Stole

Types of Membership

BLUE MEMBERS

- Most students
- Required to earn a total of **10 points**
 - At least 3 points from meetings
 - At least 3 points of service
 - At least 3 points for campus events


SILVER MEMBERS

- Full-time job (30+ hours) and/or 16+ units
 - Required to earn a total of **5 points**
 - At least 1 point from meetings
 - At least 1 point of service
 - At least 1 point for campus events

REQUIREMENTS

- GPA Requirement:
 - For those with less than 12 units in college → **3.50 GPA** using high school transcript or proof of life membership in CSF
 - For those with 12 units or more in college → **3.00 GPA** or higher
- Dues:
 - 300-500 word essay instead of monetary dues
- For those who qualify for *SILVER MEMBERSHIP*, also include your typical work schedule that shows your hours per week.
- **APPLICATION DEADLINE!**
 - **April 7th**, the Friday following our 3rd meeting

Essay Topics:

1. “What does honor society mean to you?”
 2. “Why did you pick your major?”
 3. “Explain the transfer process”
 4. “What does leadership mean to you?”
 - Or you can pick your own topic if it is related to academics, leadership, or service and must be approved by a cabinet member.

 - <https://www.cancer.org/involved/volunteer/online-and-social.html> → very easy work, must be social media literate, hard to accumulate multiple “hours”
 - <https://www.pgdp.net/c/accounts/addproofer.php> → must have PROFICIENT reading/writing skills, proofreading works of literature
