CFD Guidelines

October 27th–November 17th

MAXIMUM OF 2 CAMPUS POINTS CAN BE EARNED

FOOD ITEMS:

CANNED FOOD: Any size but must add up to 40 oz per 1 campus point

ex: pasta sauce, beans, etc.

BOXES/PACKS: 2 boxes/packs per 1 point

ex: box of juice pouches, pack of instant noodles, etc.

PASTA: 3-5 packs per 1 point

ex: mac & cheese boxes, pasta boxes, etc.

BAGS: 3-5 bags per 1 point

ex: dried beans, rice, etc.

NON-FOOD/LIQUIDS

SHAMPOO/CONDITIONER/LOTION: Two 30+oz containers per 1 point

DISH SOAP/LAUNDRY SOAP: Two 20+oz containers per 1 point

TOOTHPASTE: Three-four 4oz toothpaste tubes per 1 point

Can be dropped off at the SDO office 11/9 and 11/17 from 9-1 p.m. Make sure you say it is for AGS.

TOILETRY ITEMS

BOXES/PACKS

- diapers: 1 box per point
- Tampons: 2 boxes per point
- Baby Wipes: 3 packs per point
- Sanitary Napkins: 2 packs/boxes per 1 point
- Toilet Paper: 2 packs of 8-12 rolls per 1 point or 1 pack of 16+ rolls per point

DEODORANT: 3-5 deodorants per point

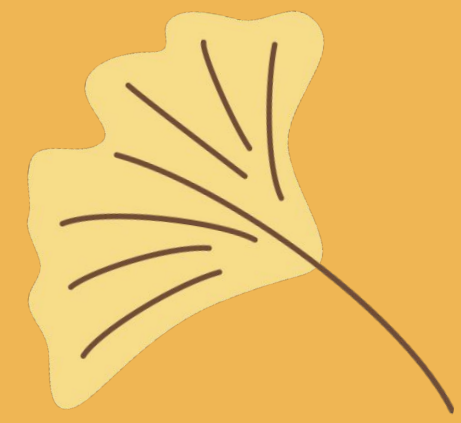
BRUSHES/COMBS: 3-5 brushes/combs per point
