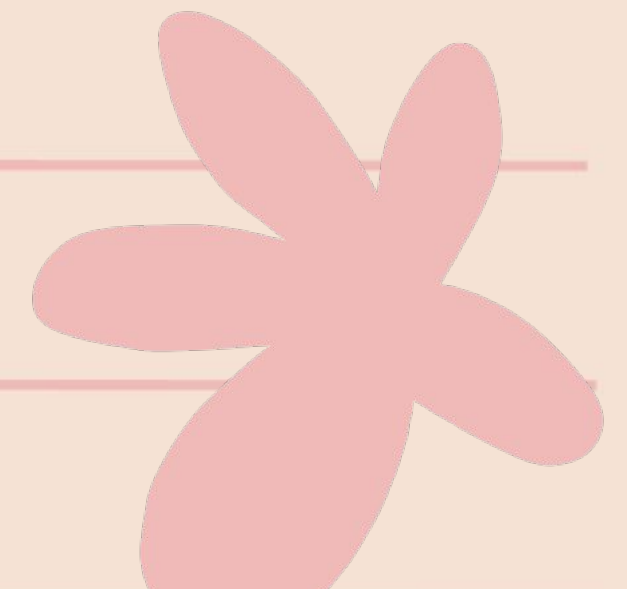

Types of Memberships

BLUE MEMBERSHIP

Required to earn a total of
10 points

- At least 3 points from meetings
- At least 3 points of campus events
- At least 3 points of community service

SILVER MEMBERSHIP

Full time job of 30+ hours
and/or students with 16+ units

Required to earn a total of 5
points

- At least 1 point from meetings
- At least 1 point of campus events
- At least 1 points of community service



Application Requirements



- **GPA Requirement:**

- **For those with less than 12 units in college**

- **3.50 GPA using high school transcript or proof of life membership in CSF**

- **For those with 12 units or more in college**

- **3.00 GPA or higher**

- **Dues:**

- **\$20 for Blue members (\$10 with proof of financial aid)**

- **\$40 for Silver members (\$20 with proof of financial aid)**

- **For those who qualify for SILVER MEMBERSHIP, also include your typical work schedule that shows your hours per week or school schedule with units**

Opportunities**

<https://www.bemyeyes.com> → requires app download, work based off of demand, very easy work

<https://www.unv.org> → long term projects, best for college application, difficult tasks

<https://translatorswithoutborders.org/volunteer/> → must be bilingual

<https://www.cancer.org/involved/volunteer/online-and-social.html> → very easy work, must be social media literate, hard to accumulate multiple “hours”

<https://www.pgdp.net/c/accounts/addproofer.php> → must have PROFICIENT reading/writing skills, proofreading works of literature

<https://careers.amnesty.org/vacancy/find/results/> → similar to UNV, work is long-term based and opportunities may be hard to find, best for college applications

<https://www.redcross.org/volunteer/become-a-volunteer.html> → type of work varies widely, most offers are in-person, very easy to find hours

<https://www.zooniverse.org/get-involved> → assisting in professional research, very user friendly to find a topic of interest for each user

<https://www.crisistextline.org/become-a-volunteer/> → very emotionally heavy work, 30 hours of mandatory, unpaid training, work is primarily from 7pm-3am
