





<u>https://careers.amnesty.org/vacancy/find/results/</u> \rightarrow similar to UNV, work is long-term based and opportunities may be hard to find, best for college applications <u>https://www.redcross.org/volunteer/become-a-volunteer.html</u> \rightarrow type of work varies widely, most offers are in-person, very easy to find hours <u>https://www.zooniverse.org/get-involved</u> \rightarrow assisting in professional research, very user friendly</u> to find a topic of interest for each user <u>https://www.crisistextline.org/become-a-volunteer/</u> \rightarrow very emotionally heavy work, 30 hours of mandatory, unpaid training, work is primarily from 7pm-3am
